UP Governor called on the Prime Minister

Discussions regarding UP floods, etc

Lucknow, 27th August 2014

Uttar Pradesh Governor Shri Ram Naik today called on the Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi at his residence at New Delhi. It was a courtesy visit.

Governor discussed various issues pertaining to Uttar Pradesh, floods was the important among those. Governor also apprised the Prime Minister about Sculptor Shri Uttam Pacharane's project of relief sculptures of 21 Paramveer Chakra martyrs.

Shri Naik also requested the Prime Minister to implement recommendations of Parliament's Petition Committee regarding leprosy affected persons. He informed Shri Modi that along with many NGOs representing leprosy affected persons he had filed Petition to the Parliament in year 2007. Thereafter the Committee has submitted its detailed recommendations which are not yet implemented. Shri Naik was the President of International Leprosy Union.

Prime Minister is also holding charge of Atomic Energy. Hence, Governor Shri Naik urged him to give justice to project affected persons of Tarapur Atomic Power Project (TAPP) III & IV. It may be recalled that about 1,250 families consisting of farmers and fishermen are affected by TAPP III & IV. The issue of their rehabilitation is pending at Mumbai High Court since last 10 years and Shri Naik has intervened and has been personally arguing in the matter.
