UPA Government on war against the people - Ram Naik

Mumbai, Friday: "UPA Government is on war against the people. CNG, PNG gas price hike is now followed by a heavy dose of increased prices of diesel, petrol, LPG and kerosene. This will definitely take the toll of the common man. Prime Minister Dr. Manmohan Singh has failed miserably in formulating pricing policy for petroleum products." said Shri Ram Naik, former Petroleum Minister while reacting on increased prices of petroleum products.

Shri Naik further stated, "The UPA government took almost six years for formulating pricing policy by appointing three different committees for the same. Yet it failed miserably to arrive at a final decision. While they have de-regulated prices of petrol, diesel has been untouched. The common-man's burden could have been reduced by lowering excise duty. Instead they have advised state governments to reduce sales - tax, knowing well that they will not do. "

"The vicious circle of price increase will further accelerate making life of common man miserable. The only solution is to unite and fight against the government," said Shri Naik at the end.
