Ram Naik demands JPC

Mumbai, Tuesday: "Resignation of the Chief Minister Shri Ashok Chavan is not enough. It is now evident that many ministers of State cabinet as well as central government along with top Defense personnel, several IAS and other senior officers are also involved in the *Adarsh* Scam. Hence a detailed enquiry into the scam by Joint Parliamentary Committee (JPC) is a must", demanded Shri Ram Naik, former petroleum Minister.

Shri Naik further warned that the BJP would not succumb to Congress's strategy to veil the scam behind the Chief Minister's resignation. By accepting Shri Chavan's resignation the Congress has at least accepted the fact of the scam.
